



Job Description

Athletic Trainer, The Academy Drum and Bugle Corps

The Academy is seeking Tour Admin Assistants for the upcoming 2024 season. Athletic Trainers provide onsite care and management of member injuries including prevention, evaluation, management and rehabilitation.

POSITION DETAILS:

- This is a paid position which requires travel with the drum corps between May 28 and August 10. Full-Tour availability is preferred but shorter terms may be considered.
- Athletic Trainers report directly to the Corps Director and Medical Team lead.
- Compensation is determined based on experience and time available. \$500/week minimum (negotiable)
- Transportation and most meals are covered by the organization during time with the corps.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 22 years of age – minimum – preference will be given to those over 25 years of age
- Must possess a bachelor's degree and athletic trainer certification
- Be able to apply dressings, tape, braces and bandages in accordance to appropriate injury management
- Must be able to perform manual therapy techniques as indicated by patient's treatment plan
- Must be able to refer patients to physicians as necessary
- Must be able to develop and implement rehabilitation programs for injured performers
- Must be able to coordinate and implement injury prevention programs and customized preventative strategies to each patient
- Must be able to minimize risk of injury through awareness, education and ergonomic recommendations
- Must be able to provide functional assessment to determine a performer's readiness to return to full participation
- Must be familiar with the requirements associated with performing in the drum corps environment
- Must be able to track and analyze injury data and provide reports to Medical team
- Must be able to provide general health and wellness educational support to members
